

## GeoTagging with GT-11/BGT-11 workflow

1. Synchronize the time of your digital camera and **GT-11/BGT-11**. Set it with your local time, although the GPS data is automatically logged in UTC time.
2. After **GT-11/BGT-11** fix its position, put it in your bag, focus on your photo shooting and enjoy your trip (as if you don't have GT-11/BGT-11).
3. Download trip data from **GT-11/BGT-11** by NVLINK program and suggest to move the "PLT.GPX" file to the same folder of your stored photos
4. Use **gpicsync** to geotag your photos. If your computer is running Chinese big-5 windows, suggest to use "g-packer", which is smaller in size and the menu is in Chinese.
5. Use "Google Picasa" to manage your photos and you can view its original location where you shoot from "Google Earth".
6. You can upload these photos with geography information to [www.flickr.com](http://www.flickr.com) , [www.panoramio.com](http://www.panoramio.com) or google to share with friends through the internet.

All above mentioned software are freeware.
